

Day 01 (15/09/2024) - Singapore 🌮 Bhutan

Flight KB 541 Dep : 1230 Arrival: 1645

With roughly over four hours flight journey from Singapore to Bhutan, you can enjoy the majestic view of the great Himalayas. Welcome to Bhutan, upon your arrival at **Paro airport** you will be received by your tour guide. Paro airport is the only international airport in the country and is one of the most beautiful airport in the world, surrounded by small helmets, mountains and hills with a meandering river next to it. The whole airport structures entwined with traditional designs and setup gives you an entire different feeling of the country. After completion of the visa formalities, we will drive to **Thimphu**, the capital city, which takes about an hour. Upon arrival at Thimphu, you will check in Hotel. If time permits, we will visit to some places nearby. **Overnight Thimphu. B/L/D**

Day 02 (16/09/2024) - Thimphu Sightseeing

We will start our day excursion with **Buddha Point**, perched on a hillock overlooking the entire capital city. The 169ft bronze Buddha is the largest in world. Get a scenic view of Thimphu city.**Takin Preserve**, wildlife reserve area for Takin, the National Animal of Bhutan. You can also visit **Bhutan National Post** to get a personalised stamp with your photo and post to your friends and families. Lunch at Folk Heritage Restaurant. After lunch, we shall take a short hike through **Wangdue Tse Nature Trail.** Towards evening, you will also visit Tashi Choe Dzong built in 1641 by Zhabdrung Ngawang Namgyal. It houses the secretariat building, the throne room and the office of the king, and the central monk body. **Overnight Thimphu. B/L/D**

Day 03(17/09/2024) -Thimphu To Punakha via Dochula Pass

Day Highlight: Wear Bhutanese National Dress

Take a leisure drive uphill to **Dochula Pass (2,300m)** which is about 45 minutes from our hotel. As you approach nearer, you can see the ridges draped with colourful prayer flags greeting you. The most fascinating destination with 108 Stupas with a stunning view of all the Himalayas. As you drive down to Punkah valley, you can witness the bhutanese villages and home style alongside the road. Lunch on the mid way. Gradually you will approach **Punakha** which is at an elevation of 1200m above the sea level. its warmer here compared to Thimphu. Punakha is the old capital of Bhutan. **Overnight Punakha B/L/D**





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Day 04 (18/09/2024) - Punakha to Phobjikha

Today after breakfast, you will take a drive to Phobjikha Valley. Its little over two hours journey through different vegetations and villages. Phobjikha is a wide valley, also a winter home to a rare species of bird called **Black Naked Crane**. It's so refreshing and quite in this valley. Upon reaching Gangtey Goenpa Village, you will stop over for lunch. After lunch, take a short nature hike through Gangtey Nature trail(1hr max), overlooking the beautiful Phobjikha valley. we shall try the hot stone bath tonight over local wine and snacks. **Overnight at Phobjikha.(Dewachen/Similar) B/L/D**



Day 05(19/09/2024) - Phobjikha to Paro, Return

After breakfast take a short walk through the village. Phobjikha is a wide and plane valley with wonderful scenic beauty. You can visit the Gangtey Monastery and the small monk school. You can make a short visit to Black Necked Crane Center to know more about the bird. Then proceed your journey back to Paro. Lunch of the mid-way. The whole journey would be fantastic with stop overs at waterfalls and beautiful places. After reaching Paro, we will do some sightseeing if time permits or leisure time at the Paro City. **Overnight at Paro**.

Day 06(20/09/2024) -Hike to Tiger Nest.

Bhutan's most iconic landmark and religious site. The name [Taktsang] translates to "The Tiger's Nest". This temple is the most holy sites in the kingdom and clings impossibly to a sheer cliff face 900 meters. It takes around 2-3-hour hike through beautiful, shady pine forests to reach the Temple. No trip to Bhutan would be complete without a visit to this remarkable heritage site. (Note: Pls wear comfortable shoes. There is a pony ride for those who feel can't make it (own expenses). After a lovely hike, perhaps you may try the hot stone bath (own expenses). Overnight at Paro, B/L/D Dinner at Farm House.
